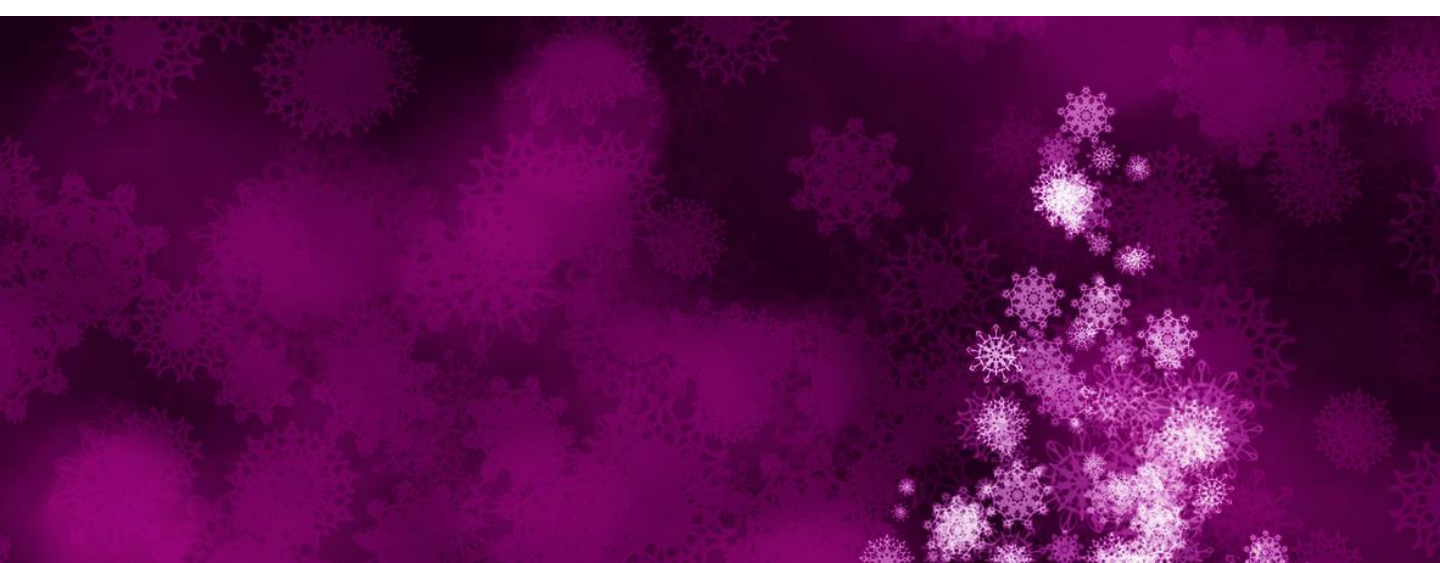

“On Christmas Eve we were told they found a tumour in Findlay’s chest, the size of a grapefruit. They told us it was crushing down onto his right lung.
